It works so much better this way. Thank the Lord for using CWE to build our classrooms which are a great blessing. We are providing lunch for the teachers and students. Many families are struggling financially.

I baptized 3 people recently. We are taking opportunities to witness to people; we went to a park and led 3 people to our precious Savior Jesus. As we were sharing with a smiling gentleman, he said “no Español, yo India” my wife asked is he spoke English; he did so we shared the precious news with him and he was very happy to receive the Lord in his life, recognizing that God had brought us there for him. He also shared that a “coyote” abandoned him and his family on their way to the USA when the pandemic started. He is trying to go back to his country.

We cherish your prayers for us and the ministry. We are praying for the Lord to send a God fearing man for me to train with the goal to take my place later. Please pray with us about this. Thank you very much for your faithful involvement in missions. We are honored to represent the Lord and you all who have a part with us.
