The school is well on its way. We have four new students. Thank the Lord we led some parents to the Lord. Jeremy is an 8-year-old deaf boy with Cerebral Palsy, very bright and is eager to learn. We led his mom Johana to Christ. She is a single mom of three and very grateful that we have a deaf school for her son. They barely make it as she works to support her family.

Jordy, 14, is another student who is mute; his grandmother is raising him. Jordy is starting to learn Sign Language and to communicate. He has the hardest time to retain what he learns.

Benjamin is a very shy young man who has a speech impediment, so he is learning Sign Language to be able to communicate and learn how to read and write. Most of all, they all need to learn about Jesus and His salvation message.

Freddy is deaf. After his mother pulled him out of the school three times, she came back begging to give Freddy a last opportunity and promised she would not take him again. Freddy has graduated from high school somewhere else, but he can't read nor write. He is now attending church and school faithfully so he is learning how to read and write. A few years ago we led Freddy's grandfather to Christ; he had lived and worked in the U.S. for years but sadly he had become a devil worshiper; his life was a mess, when he went back to Ecuador, one of his children left him in poverty. The Lord sent us to him. He was living like a beggar, but in God's mercy, Freddy's mom took care of him although she did not have much, she gave food and shelter. This grandfather gave his heart to our merciful precious Heavenly Father that day. He went to be with the Lord shortly after that. It brings us to tears to reflect of God's mercy for us sinners. Praise the Lord.

We recently arrived in the USA for our furlough, and now we are on the road visiting supporting churches and trying to get into new churches. The last Sunday in our church, the Lord allowed me and the new pastor, Dennis, to baptize eight people. After praying for almost two years, the Lord confirmed and gave me and Pastor Dennis peace about his being the new pastor of the MBCD. The Lord is expanding our ministry; we will be starting a new church and deaf school in the outskirts of the Central jungle of Peru.
