This is not the email we had hoped to write, but we are trusting God even though the unwanted. Jackie does have cancer. We still don't know all the details, but will share what we know and update you as we know more so that you can be praying effectively.

She will have surgery the latter part of February (not scheduled yet) to be followed by 4-7 weeks of radiation. Chemo is yet to be determined. They have a test to run, if that number is below 25, then no chemo. If the results are higher than 25, chemo will be added to the above.

We have some specific requests. The first would be for the cancer to be healed during this process. Our immediate request is that the test number would come back below 25 to avoid chemo. Lastly, just for finances and insurance as we navigate all of this.

We covet all your prayers, especially the many of you who have walked this journey yourselves or with a loved one. You'll be able to pray in ways that we can't even begin to comprehend at this point. We will welcome any encouragement you can share.

We want to praise God, who has been so good to bring us comfort and peace in the midst of all the unknowns. We are clinging to verses like Psalm 46:1, God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble.

Life will look a little different than we anticipated and plans are on hold for the present. We are so thankful for our heavenly Father who knows the beginning, the end and EVERYTHING in between!
