We trust you have a wonderful Christmas and a good celebration of our Savior Jesus Christ Resurrection Sunday. "Jesus is risen! Yes, Christ is risen indeed!" I like the way the Angel announced Christ's resurrection to the women that Sunday morning at the tomb. "Why do you seek the living One among the dead? He is not here, but He has risen" (Luke 24:5-6). Brethern, we serve a Living God through whom we have life in Christ. How do you prepare to welcome Him at His second coming? He is our hope, the hope of the world we are making known.

We also had an excellent celebration of our Savior's triumph over death. I preached on Christ's resurrection from the three synoptic Gospels and the gospel of John. That Sunday morning, five people submitted their lives to Christ. Christ's resurrection is the center of the Gospel preached by the Apostles at the birth of the Church. Without Christ's resurrection, there would be no Church. The resurrection of Christ is the foundation of the Christian faith.

Defending the hope of those who died in Christ, Paul asserts, "If Christ has not been raised, your faith is worthless; you are still in your sins. The Church, the body of Christ, exists because Christ has risen. Alleluia! "If Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is vain, your faith also is vain" (1 Corinthians 15:14).

Our church ministry projects in Misahome are progressing very well. We appreciate your prayers and involvement in these projects.

In our recent newsletters, we reported the current stage and the estimated cost of the Church building and Pastoral housing project to you.

We wanted to give you an overview of the church construction projects. We currently have:

1. Three classrooms,
2. Guest housing,
3. A powerful solar system.
4. Church Storage
5. Public restroom for the church,

However, we have more to do regarding our construction projects in Misahome. Two major projects remain untouched: the Pastoral House and the sanctuary building for worship.

As a reminder, after reviewing every aspect of the construction with the architect and the mason, both constructions are estimated to be **\$161,015.29**

Actually, we are preparing for our VBS 2024 on July 15 to 19. It will be a special event to reach out to children and young people with the saving Gospel of the resurrected Christ. Last year 2023, two hundred eighty- nine children attended our VBS program. We are praying that this year will be more fruitful. We are excited to announce that four volunteer workers will be leaving the States for our VBS 2024. They all have their tickets paid already. What a blessing! We wanted to ask you to help us host our guests in a hospitable manner for the glory of God. We need water for their use in the toilet and kitchen. We also need to have them stay in a painted rooms, not in dirty rooms. Therefore, **we need \$7,500** to install a water pump system to bring water into the building (kitchen, restrooms etc) and painting. I believe that God could provide \$7,500 from the wallets of His people to supply this crucial need. Please understand that this is not a manipulation, but a matter of fact. God has already blessed us with all spiritual and material blessings. He simply asks you to give for His works, especially for the water pump and painting in Misahome
